### Socio-economic background of this project

For decades, the world has recorded consistently high level of burn injuries.

#### Social significance of this project:

- Providing high quality medical care to victims of burn injuries, cold injuries, chemical burns, and electric shock;
- The application of modern approaches to medical treatment, diminishing unsatisfactory results in the treatment of patients with severe and widespread burns (with more than 40% of the body surface);
- Reduced rates of mortality and disability in cases of deep burns, especially for the working-age population and children.











# Causes of high mortality among patients with severe thermal injuries

- 1. The substandard material and technical basis of the existing burn center at Kyiv Municipal Clinical Hospital no. 2.
- 2. A shortage of sterile boxes.
- 3. The incapacity to fully apply modern technologies, including technology for cultivating cells and tissues to treat.
- 4. The absence of a rehabilitation unit.
- 5. Luck of modern plastic surgery centers

















# Main advantages of the project

- 1. The possibility of cooperating with investors according to the principles of a public-private partnership.
- 2. Joint implementation of new technologies in the process of cell and tissue generation (3% coverage).
- 3. Making a profit for the investor through the introduction of new technologies at the hospital::
  - Reproductive (30% coverage);
  - For high-tech diagnostic testing (55% coverage);
  - Plastic surgery (65% coverage).

The future medical complex will include:

-1 start-up facilities – a new building for the Burn Treatment Center with 105 beds (area – 30.0 thsd sq.m);
2 start-up facilities –

reconstruction of existing buildings (for head and gynecological health) with 210 beds (area – 30.0 thsd sq.m);



- Total capacity of the future complex 315 beds.
- Total area of the complex 45.0 thsd sq.m
